Members of the Parliament of Sachsen-Anhalt to visit Ireland (14 – 17 November 2011)

A delegation of 6 members of the Committee for Culture and Education of the Regional Parliament (Landtag) of Sachsen-Anhalt, a constituent State of the Federal Republic of Germany, will pay an official visit to Ireland from 14 to 17 November this year. The main purpose of the mission is to learn more about the Irish school system and to exchange ideas about school management and educational policy with high ranking representatives of the Department of Education and Skills as well as members of the Joint Committee on Jobs, Social Protection and Education in the Oireachtas. Furthermore, the delegation will meet with teachers and pupils of primary and secondary schools in Dublin and Bray.

The delegation will be headed by the Chairman of the Committee for Culture and Education, Dr. Gunnar Schellenberger (Christian Democratic Union) and comprise five other deputies representing the Social Democratic Party, "Die Linke" (The Left) and Bündnis 90/Die Grünen (The Greens) respectively. The Minister for Culture of Sachsen-Anhalt, Mr. Stephan Dorgerloh, Member of Parliament, will also be part of the delegation.
